At Glen Waverley Primary School we are fortunate to offer a large and vibrant Music program. Students learn music from Foundation to Year 6 and have the opportunity to participate in Senior Choir, Junior Choir, String Ensemble, School Band and Drum Ensemble.

In the classroom students explore beat, rhythm, pitch, melody and composition through singing, body percussion, movement and sight-reading music. Students also use and learn a variety of instruments including keyboards, guitars, ukuleles, xylophones and percussion.

We also offer Music Innovation to small groups of students who elect to learn music on a deeper level. Glen Waverley Primary School also participates in the Victorian State School Spectacular each year. This allows our students to experience a production at a professional standard.

The Glen Waverley Primary School Languages program engages students grasping a new language and improving their Mandarin skills through a range of rigorous learning experiences. Targeting the complex language of Chinese through learning of conversational skills, reading, and writing simplified Chinese characters and integrating whole school inquiry-based topics, the program also deepens students' understanding of Chinese through stories, songs, and cultural events.

What the students of GWPS say about the Language program:

At Glen Waverley Primary School we have an expansive and engaging Visual Arts program taught fortnightly in a dedicated Art Room. Students have opportunities to create artworks with a variety of art materials and mediums, linking our school values and inquiry units. We offer multiple extra programs such as Art Innovation, Artist in School, lunchtime Art clubs and after school art classes.

We take great pride in our Visual Arts program and seek to showcase children's work throughout the school and wider community. We also encourage the children to value their learning by displaying it at home or storing it in a folio.

What the students of GWPS say about the Art program:

At Glen Waverley Primary School, all learners participate in one hour of Physical Education each week with a specialist PE teacher. We aim to develop the learner's confidence, coordination, and physical literacy through a range of individual and group learning tasks. There is a consistent focus on respect and encouraging learners to interact with each other in a positive manner.

In Foundation to Year 2, learners participate in learning tasks and minor games designed to develop their fundamental motor skills (FMS). Throughout the lessons, we also aim to develop their understanding of why physical activity is important and how our body reacts to exercise.

In Years 3-6, the learners are further extending the development of their fundamental motor skills in order to participate in games and sports, both within and beyond our school.
